### Behind The Lilac Hedge

Not just for small spaces, the dwarf Korean lilac (*Syringa meyeri* "Palibin") is large enough at five feet tall and seven feet wide to add heft to the spring border, while not overwhelming the average suburban lot. The dense growth habit of "Palibin" lilac makes it a good candidate for a hedge. As a bonus, the shrubs are resistant to mildew.

Noteworthy Characteristics. *Syringa meyeri*, commonly called Meyer lilac or Korean lilac, was found growing in a garden near Beijing, China by Frank Meyer in 1909. It is not known to exist in the wild. It is a compact, rounded, slow-growing, deciduous shrub that matures to 5-8' tall and spreads to 10' wide.

Noteworthy Characteristics. *Syringa pubescens* subsp. *patula*, commonly called Manchurian lilac, is more upright growing than *Syringa meyeri* or *Syringa pubescens* subsp. *microphylla* and grows to 9' tall and as wide. Lilac-purple flowers, 4-6" long, often occur in pairs, at the branch tips. Genus name comes from the Greek word *syrinx* meaning tube or pipe in reference to the pith-filled but easily ...
