In November 2007, the Nuffield Council on Bioethics published a report Public health: ethical issues, 1 based on the findings of a working party that I chaired. The report tackles these very issues and sets out a model for public-health ethics which we call the "stewardship model".

Stewardship In addition to improving overall levels of population health, objectives are likely to be framed in terms of equity, coverage, access, quality, and patients' rights. National policy may also define the relative roles and responsibilities of the public, private and voluntary sectors - as well as civil society - in the provision and financing of health care.
